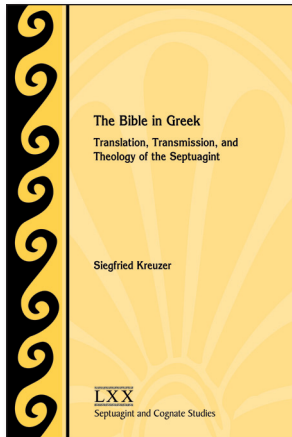

THE BIBLE IN GREEK Translation, Transmission, and Theology of the Septuagint *Siegfried Kreuzer*

The Septuagint, the translation of the Hebrew Bible into Greek, was used by the Greek-speaking Jewish communities in Egypt and other countries of the Hellenistic world and the Roman Empire. As such, it also became the foundation for the spread of Christianity and the reference text for the New Testament authors. This volume, with up-to-date papers in English and German, covers a cross-section of the most important subjects and research topics on the Septuagint, including the Hellenistic background of and reasons for the translation, the Hebrew reference texts, translation principles, and early revisions of the translation. It contains chapters on editorial principles and the quest for the earliest text form, on the relevance of quotations in the New Testament, on the transmission of the text, and on two of the oldest and most important manuscripts of the Bible in Greek.

SIEGFRIED KREUZER is Professor of Old Testament at the Kirchliche Hochschule/Protestant University in Wuppertal, Germany. He is author and co-editor for the research project Septuaginta Deutsch (the German translation of the Septuagint with commentary volumes and the multivolume *Handbuch zur Septuaginta*). He is currently the editor of the *Journal of Septuagint and Cognate Studies*.
